Failure to use turn signals causes 2 million crashes

Your car's turn signals serve as an important safety device. Yet, many drivers seldom or never use their signals, which is a mistake. According to the Society of Automotive Engineers, 2 million car accidents occur every year due to a driver's failure to use a turn signal and that more than a fourth of drivers don't use signals at all.

Let them know


Turn signals let other drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists know your intention to turn. In residential areas, you must signal 100 feet in advance and in other areas signal 200 feet in advance. Without a signal, others are mis-led.

Lane change

Be sure to use a turn signal when changing lanes. You should activate the signal 5 seconds before merging into the new lane.

Using turn signals makes travel safer for you and is a gesture of courtesy to the drivers sharing the road with you.
