We further find the following:

We find that the total amount of damages suffered by the Plaintiff Barbara Jackson as a proximate result of the occurrence in question is \$ 1,897,000, itemized as follows:

The disfigurement resulting from the injury. \$ 250,000

The loss of a normal life experienced and reasonably certain to be experienced in the future as a result of the injuries \$ 500,000

The pain and suffering experienced and reasonably certain to be experienced in the future as a result of the injuries \$ 500,000

The emotional distress experienced and reasonably certain to be experienced in the future \$ 500,000

The value of time and earnings lost \$ 37,000

The value of future earnings lost \$ 110,000

The reasonable expense of necessary medical care, treatment, and services received, and the present cash value of the reasonable expenses of medical care, treatment and services reasonably certain to be received in the future \$ 1,000,000
